Soothe Body and Soul in Two Vast Baths

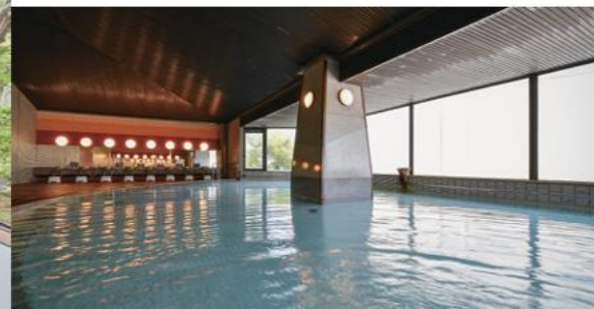
Taiyoden Hot Spring Bath

RYOYU

Our Ryouyu hall was selected as the venue for the official shogi title game held in October 2024. Today, it serves as a VIP room, and guests can enjoy a taste of what game day was like in the gallery. It is wallpapered entirely with Echizen Washi paper, featuring a design evocative of the trunk of a beautiful pine tree — the literal meaning of "Mimatsu" — or a dragon's scales, for a truly



one-of-a-kind space. To commemorate the 2024 shogi title game to be held in Awara, members of the public were invited to propose name suggestions for the venue, and "Ryouyu" was chosen from the over 70 submissions from throughout the prefecture.

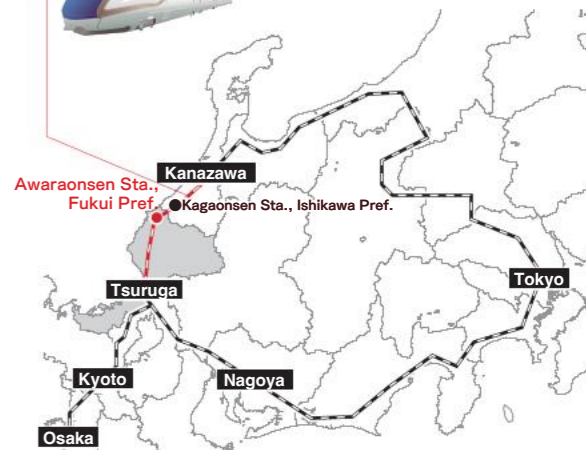

Facility Information

- Five-story steel-reinforced concrete building surrounding a private garden, compliant with fire safety standards. Total 69 guest rooms (of which 28 guest rooms with open-air bath; 2 Universal rooms, either Western-style twin or Japanese-style twin; 8 Japanese/Western-style rooms with open-air baths at Bettei Biyu; and 22 Japanese-style modern rooms). Maximum occupancy 300 guests.
- Shared bathing areas: Taiyoden and Meigetsuden.
- Banquet halls: Shousenkaku large hall (400 tatami mats, approx. 650 m²), Taiho medium-sized hall (200 tatami mats, approx. 325 m²), plus 4 others.
- Heian conference room (school-style, 120-person capacity).
- Facilities open to the public: Tokiwa garden lounge, Kaguya café, Fukuninki boutique.
- Parking: 10 bus spaces, 100 car spaces.

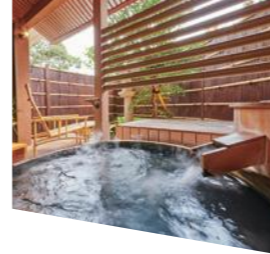

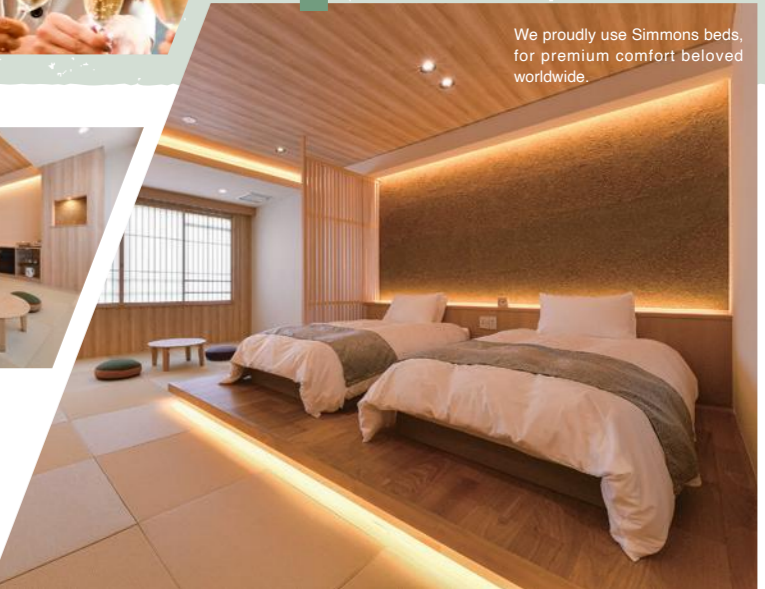
